

CCI1: INTERDEPENDENCES ACROSS LIFE DOMAINS. COMPETITION, COMPLEMENTARITY AND COMPENSATION

Abstract: This module presents the LIVES Cross-Cutting Issue I (CCI1) understanding of vulnerability as a multidimensional process over the life course. Under this framework, the life course is seen as a multidimensional pathway made of interdependent trajectories of, among others, education, family, employment, residence and health. CCI1 analyzes the interdependences and spillover effects across these different domains of the life course, highlighting the centrality of questions regarding processes of competition, complementarity and compensation between life domains and over the life course. The workshop will provide participants with a better understanding of these processes in the production of individual well-being, by means of theoretical lectures, discussion of empirical illustrations and indicators, as well as hands-on practice with an ad hoc dataset or data sets brought by participants.
